

Today's popular digital tools come in two flavors. Web apps frequently use Adobe Flash and do not function on iPad, and mobile apps are often made for a specific device. While you might not find the same tool as a web app and as a mobile app, you can usually find an equivalent.

effects. Trim, loop and stretch

audio clips.

Record summaries, skits, mock interviews, radio shows, news segments, reflections and perhaps add music and sound effects.

Croak.it Tap the Record button to record

up to 30 seconds. When done,

your recording is automatically

uploaded to Croak.it's website. You can copy and share the URL.



Record up to 3 minutes of audio.

Optionally choose an image and

share the audio online.

Recordings are given a URL at

audioboo.fm.

Click the button to start audio recording. When done, you can download the mp3 file or copy the recording URL for sharing.


