
Punnett Squares

Father's Genes



The father is heterozygous for dimples (has them). The mother is homozygous dominant for dimples (has them).

In this example, since every combination of alleles contains a dominant gene there is a 100% chance that the offspring will have dimples.

* In order to inherit a recessive trait, offspring must receive BOTH recessive alleles.
